Psalms 100

Make a joyful shout to the Lord, all you lands! ² Serve the Lord with gladness; Come before His presence with singing. ³ Know

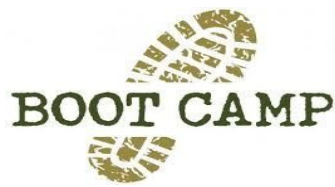

WILMA BERRY (Celeste's mother) is suffering with rheumatoid arthritis.

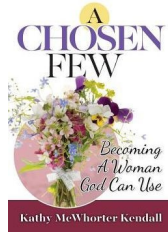

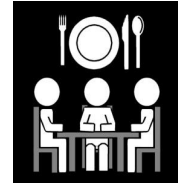
